

Installation instructions i4F HerringB/ONE



- · Firstly, measure the room and mark out where the middle is;
- Position the T-square's top angle on the middle line then align the tips of 2 panels and click into place;
- Tap gently with PVC mallet to lock. Make sure that the groove side of the plank is always facing inwards.



- Continue to install panels outwards on each side across the width of the room;
- Always use the T-square, only moving it once you have locking in the panels;
- All i4F herringB/ONE panels fit each other, so no need to worry about alternating boards.



Install the second row

 Angle in the long side of the board and slide across to the short side. Drop the short side and lock by using the PVC mallet.



 Prepare the end panels on each side. Use a 45° square to cut the panel and remove the excess.




- Gently slide the 2 rows to the wall: add spacers in between each tip and the wall;
- Measure the distance from the end panel to the wall minus 5mm (0.2inch).



• Continue installing and lock in all remaining panels.





- Measure and cut to size panels and fill up empty triangle spaces at the end of the room;
- Remove spacers after installation;
- Install baseboards/plinths to finish the room.



Dissassembling

- Place the disassembling wedge under the plank to be disengaged;
- Gently tap the adjacent plank with the PVC mallet. Slowly lift the plank upwards to loosen it.
